John Osgood, upon his arrival in New England, sojourned at Ipswich, but shortly after chose Newbury as the place of his residence. There he remained until his removal and settlement at Andover which occurred in or just previous to 1645. That he had early determined to remove from Newbury, which, in the view of the inhabitants, was already overcrowded, is shown by the fact that he was one of the petitioners for, and chairman of, the committee to obtain a settlement at Winnacunnet, now Hampton, New Hampshire. This was in 1638.

In September, 1644, an attempt was made to form a church at Andover, the meeting being held at Rowley, as there were not sufficient accommodations at Andover, but on account of a technicality the organization was not effected until October, 1645. The names of the first ten members, freeholders (as required by law to constitute a church), were John Woodbridge, teacher, John Osgood, Robert Barnard, John Frye, Nicholas Holt, Richard Barker, Joseph Parker, Nathan Parker, Richard Blake, Edmund Faulkner; given in order of their signing.
