¹ That Domine Schaets officiated at this baptism is shown by the fact that the church was at this time without a settled minister, and that he presided at a Consistory meeting on the 15th of Oct., 1669, when an Elder and Deacon were elected, who were ordered to be "ordained next Sunday by Domine Schaets."

² Although it is not directly stated that eleven of these baptisms of the 18th of June 1671 (Nos. 108-118) were performed by Domine Schaets, it is evident that he was the officiating minister, for on the preceding day (17th of June) he was in Kingston, and, in the absence of a settled minister, presided at a meeting of the Consistory. Preceding the last baptism of this list (No. 119) it is stated in the record that it was performed by Domine Schaets.
